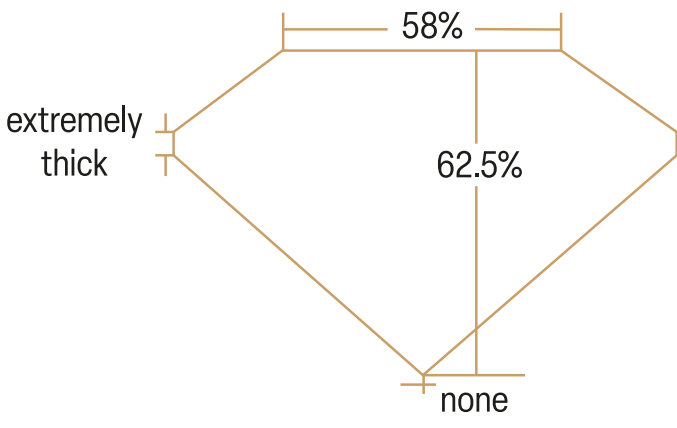

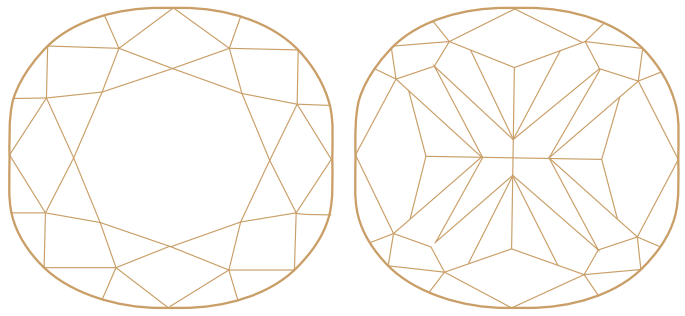

KEY TO SYMBOLS & EXPLANATIONS

- **Carat Weight*:** For moissanite, the carat weight is measured in DEW (Diamond Equivalent Weight), which represents the equivalent weight if the stone were a diamond with the same size and density. One carat equals 0.20 grams. This is the standard measurement for moissanite in the gemological industry.
- **Color Grade:** A measure of the degree of colorlessness. The scale ranges from D (colorless) to Z (light color).
- **Clarity Grade:** A measure of the relative absence of inclusions and blemishes. Grades range from Flawless (no inclusions or blemishes visible under 10x magnification) to Included (inclusions are obvious under 10x magnification).
- **Cut Grade:** A grade that assesses the quality of a moissanite's cut, which determines its brilliance and sparkle. The scale ranges from Excellent to Poor.
- **Polish:** The smoothness of the moissanite's facets.
- **Symmetry:** The precision and alignment of the facets.
- **Fluorescence:** The glow a moissanite emits when exposed to ultraviolet (UV) light.
